3. Aims & Objectives

Aims

- To engage with the community to raise awareness of the impact of climate change on our environment in Calne Without
- To support Wiltshire Council initiative to reduce emissions and to make the county carbon neutral by 2030
- To produce a carbon reduction strategy and associated policies for Calne Without Parish Council
- To create a delivery Plan at the latest by June 2022, with the goal of completing the Plan by the end of 2021
- To pursue a community led approach to the initiatives which engages, empowers, enables and communicates with the entire Calne Without Parish
- To join and work alongside and in concert with Wiltshire local organisations in the delivery of policies and a Plan to support the achievement of carbon neutrality in Wiltshire by 2030

Objectives

- Establish a Climate Emergency and Environment Working Group
- Identify a carbon reduction strategy and associated policies for Calne Without Parish Council and co-opt appropriate and necessary community volunteers from interested groups to assist with this work
- Engage with the Wiltshire Council Climate Strategy and with local organisations to include (but not limited to) the following:

Create a delivery Plan at the latest by June 2022, with the goal of completing the Plan by the end of 2021. Prepare an initial action plan by November 2021.
