# 8.3 Neighbourhood Plan - Parish online mapping

The proposal was unanimously approved.

# 9. Planning – Cllrs

To consider the planning applications currently out for consultation. List Circulated.

PL/2021/09459 – Hill View Pewsham,

The Councillors discussed the above planning application

It was proposed to object to the application with the following comments;

- Detrimental impact on road safety on the A4 London Road: the proposal will result in traffic to or from Hill View exiting onto the A4 at a point with significantly worse visibility & lines of sight than the existing point of egress. (The lines of sight at this point are severely curtailed in one direction by the Pewsham Garage, and in the other by the bus stop.)
- Detrimental impact on the users of Bridlepath CALW81 from the addition of more vehicular traffic.
- Impact of Flood Risk: there are no details of how the applicant intends to cross the existing land drainage ditch and ensure that there is no detrimental impact on land drainage and flood risk in the vicinity.
- Increase in noise and disturbance to the residents of The Retreat, The Cottage and Upper Cottage through the diversion of vehicular traffic immediately past their property.

• Impact on Landscape Character and Conservation: the proposed gateway and associated removal of trees and hedgerow to create the access will have a detrimental visual impact on the existing field boundary and rural landscape setting.

It was unanimously agreed to object to the planning application with the associated comments.

## 10. Road safety feasibility group stage one report

Presentation of the Stage one Report by Richard Fitter of Entrans

Richard Fitter presented the report and the Councillors then discussed the report.

It was noted that the report was very strong and good value for money.

It was proposed to add 'site 16 Old Derry Hill' to the list of sites to be moved forward to stage 2 as the proposed solutions at this site were relatively simple.

# Recommendation; That the Council Approve the sites to be taken forward to stage two

It was unanimously agreed to take forward the 10 identified sites to stage 2 with the addition of 'Site 16 – Old Derry Hill'

# 11. Establishment of a Highways, Transport & Road Safety Working Group

It is proposed to establish a Highways, Transport & Road Safety Working Group, comprising of 7 councillors, to address all aspects relating to road safety, speed reduction, highways, parking and public transport matters. This Working Group would replace the Road Safety Feasibility Group.

# Recommendation: that the Council approves the creation of a Highways, Transport & Road Safety Working Group, to replace the Road Safety Feasibility Group.

The Cllrs discussed the proposal, the members of the Road Safety Group (Cllrs Rees, Robbins, Deedigan, Barnes and Price) would change to the Highways, Transport & Road Safety Working Group, with the addition of Cllr Songhurst and Fossa

The proposal and membership of the new working group was unanimously approved

## **12. Budget Proposals from Finance Committee**

The Finance Committee have prepared a draft budget proposals based on the principles agreed in 11th October 2021 Council meeting. Draft documents circulated for review.

Recommendation; The Council is requested to consider the Draft Budget for 2022/23 presented above and to identify any changes that it would like to see incorporated in the Final Budget, to be presented for formal approval at the Parish Council Meeting of 13<sup>th</sup> December 2021.

Cllr Barnes, presented the planned budget, explained the precept and tax base,

There was a discussion about the aim for a zero increase and the longevity of such an objective.

It was Proposed to amend the draft budget to bring the precept equal to that requested for the previous financial year.

## 15. Facebook page

The Engagement and Participation working group propose the Council create and use a Facebook page to help promote the work of the Council and increase engagement. A draft Social media Policy has been circulated for Review.

The Cllrs discussed the use of social media the pros and cons and the other social media avenues that could be used in future.

A small amendment was requested to the social media policy. To ensure it covered all protected characteristics.

It was unanimously agreed to approve the social media policy with the slight amendments and approve use of Facebook as a Communication method.

# 16. Delegations scheme for use in an emergency.

Councillors to give consideration to approving a scheme of delegation for emergency use.

Recommendation; Should the Parish Council be unable to form a quorum due to Councillors unable to attend physical meetings because of Covid infection or self-isolating (proven by a positive test) or unable to attend a public meeting due to vulnerability to the Covid virus then the Council agrees that in the interest of ensuring the Council meets its responsibilities powers shall be delegated to the Clerk. The scheme of delegation and reporting to be as laid out in the attached document.

It was unanimously approved to approve the scheme of delegation.

## 17. Queens jubilee

Councillors to discuss if the Parish Council wishes to mark the Queens Jubilee in June 2022.

It was agreed that the Clerk would look at ideas to circulate prior to the next meeting.

## 18. Report into upgrade of CALW65 footpath/ cycleway

The cllrs discussed the proposals in the report circulated prior to the meeting.

Following the discussions the following proposal was voted upon

## It is Proposed that -

a) The scheme to Improve the CALW65 Cycleway/Footpath between the A4 and Petty Lane including signing, be endorsed and allocation made in the budget for funding of up to £40k from the Studley Gardens CIL funding.

b) West ward members be authorised to enter negotiations with relevant parties to develop a detailed design.

C) neither of the above preclude us from taking further investigations regarding the complaints process to Wiltshire council/local government ombudsmen
