Nomination papers must be hand delivered to the **Returning Officer or his appointed Electoral Staff (not Reception Staff)** at **The Main Reception, Council Offices, Wiltshire Council, Monkton Park, Chippenham, Wiltshire, SN15 1ER** during office hours between 10am and 4pm Monday to Friday, on any day after the date of this notice but must be received no later than 4pm on Monday, 20 December 2021.

5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 20 January 2022.

6. Applications to register to vote must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 4 January 2022. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.

7. Applications, Amendments or cancellations to existing postal, postal proxy and proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday, 5 January 2022.

8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday, 12 January 2022.

9. A person can apply to vote by 'emergency' proxy if they learn they cannot go to the polling station because of their occupation, service or employment, or a medical condition, illness or disability arises after 5pm on Wednesday, 12 January 2022. The application must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Thursday, 20 January 2022.
