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1. PEWSHAM WARD

Asset: The Well House

Location: A342 Old Derry Hill

Ward: Pewsham Ward

Date of Assessment: 27th January 2025

Description:

The structured is a Grade II Listed Building. From the listing description:

Well-house, c1900, circular, 6 timber posts with arched braces carrying conical stone slate roof with ball finial. Circular pennant stone well-head with radiating pennant stone paving around. Top plate with painted inscription 'Here quench your thirst and mark in me an emblem of true charity who while my bounty bestow am neither heard nor seen to flow. Repaid by fresh supplies from heaven for every cup of water given'. Identical to well-houses set up by the Poynder family of Hartham Park at Biddestone, Colerne and Hilmarton, Wilts.



Condition: Poor

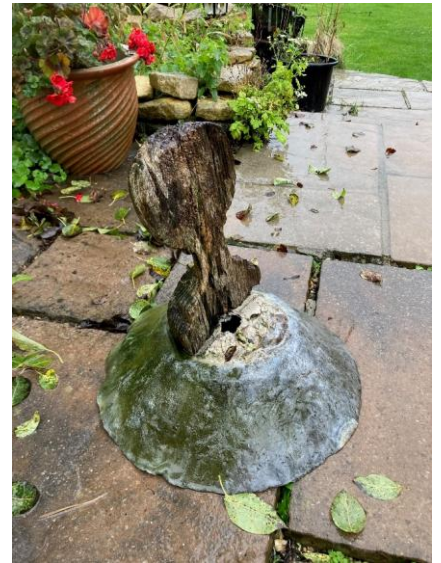
Condition notes:

Significant repairs were undertaken to the Well House in 2002. The Parish Council commissioned Wiltshire Historic Buildings Trusts to undertake a condition survey in February 2024. The key findings and recommendations from this were:

“At the inspection of 2022 it was noted that the oak finial had split. One half of the finial has now broken away and the lead capping to the top of the cone is dislodged. Recent storms and been severe and it seems likely that this was storm damage, possibly aggravated by overhanging branches close to the roof.”

“Recommendations for action:

- *Cut back all branches overhanging or close to the structure to minimise the risk of physical damage to the roof tiles and finial.*
- *Carefully take down the remains of the finial for repair or replacement.*
- *At the apex check all the lead fixings and make secure prior to the refixing of the existing lead capping. It may be desirable to provide additional fixings and this can be determined when repair is undertaken.*
- *Use the remains of the oak finial as the template for a replacement, either in oak or a suitable close-grained indigenous timber alternative. Refix, pinned as the existing. It may be possible to repair the finial but this seems unlikely and may not prove long-lasting.*
- *Check lower course of tiles at the roadside and realign. (Appear to have been disturbed).*
- *Glue small piece of oak (to follow the grain to the base of the post to minimise weathering).”*



Since the survey was undertaken in February:

- In May 2024, the tree that had grown up in the hedge next to the well house was removed by the Bowood Estate, removing the chance of further damage from its branches.
- In September 2024, the rest of the finial and the lead apex cap fell from the roof and are held by the parish council.
- In December 2024, a large branch fell from the ancient oak tree in the hedge to the north west of the well house, dislodging a number of stone tiles. The branch was cleared by the Bowood Estate.

Recommendations for remedial work (if any):

The following remedial work is recommended and is in hand:

- Using the remains of the finial as a template, make a replacement oak finial and fix to the retained lead apex cap (order placed).



- At the apex check all the lead fixings and make secure; provide additional fixings as necessary. Refix the finial, pinned as before (quotation received for work).
- Check the stone slates and realign and replace as necessary.
- Glue small piece of oak (to follow the grain to the base of the post) to minimise weathering.
