



**REQUEST FROM Derry Hill & Studley HEARTBEAT (DH&SH)
TO DERRY HILL & STUDLEY AREA PARISH COUNCIL (PC) FOR 2026 FINANCIAL
SUPPORT TO MAINTAIN THE 6, ESTABLISHED DEFIBRILLATORS WITHIN THE PARISH.**

Background:

Since 2014, the objective of the DH&SH group was and is, to facilitate the provision and maintenance of the 6 defibs that serve the area to the nationally accepted access times. In 2026 two of these defibs' reach their "end of life" expiry dates.

Both the Petty Lane- Lansdowne Hall and the Studley Lane - Methodist Chapel (both installed in 2014) have rusty cases and failing seals on the cabinets and DEFIB units have reached their "end of life" date (10- 12 years). These need to be replaced in 2026 with the new design cabinet - auto heater, LED light etc. to ensure the facilities are maintained for the community.

Past funds provided by the PC have covered the maintenance of these facilities with DSH&SH funds supporting the training, publicity and support operations. 2026 sees a greater demand on funds and DH&SH therefore continues to seek assistance to maintain the defib facilities.

2026 Funding Request:

DH&SH request the PC continue to assist in the maintenance of the defib facility by funding the replacement/installation of one of these units. (DH&SH funding the second and 2026 consumables costs for the other units, training, information leaflets, replacement parts, and any major unforeseen event/repair/electrical supply failures etc.) DH&SH therefore request that the PC grant the sum of:

£2,600.00 (two thousand six hundred GBP)
