Issue Details

Location of Issue:	Black Dog Hill, Studley
Community Area:	Calne
Parish or Town Council:	Derry Hill and Studley Parish Council
Nature of Issue:	<p>Approximately 8% of Studley residents live to the east of the Black Dog.</p> <p>Local amenities for these residents which includes the shop and post office, school, church and chapels, village hall, scout hut and recreation area are in Derry Hill.</p> <p>The safest walking route between the east of Studley and Derry Hill village is via Old Road which is on the South side of the A4.</p> <p>Studley is on the North side of the A4 thus the pedestrian route means crossing the A4 at its junction with Old Road on Black Dog Hill by the Black Dog Pub. The speed limit on the A4 is 50mph without any designated crossing point for these members of the community to access the footpath on the South side of the A4 east of the Old Road junction.</p> <p>This situation is inherently unsafe; it isolates this area of the community from their local facilities and encourages the use of vehicles for short local journeys which in turn creates unnecessary traffic in Derry Hill</p>
How long has it been an issue?	Historic
What would you like done to resolve this issue?	<p>The construction of an Enhanced Design Road crossing in accordance with the Wiltshire Pedestrian Crossing Practice Note, Section 3, design 3.2 Enhanced dropped kerb crossing.</p> <p>White lining at the crossing creating a narrowing effect on the carriageway and emphasising the crossing point</p>


